

PRIVACY POLICY

Future Fanbase B.V. respects your privacy. We comply with the Dutch Data Protection Act (*Wet Bescherming Persoonsgegevens*) and the Dutch Telecommunications Act (*Telecommunicatiewet*). In this Privacy Policy you can read what kind of personal data we collect and how we store, protect and use your personal data. Furthermore, you can read for which purposes we will use your personal data and with which third parties your data will be shared.

What does this Privacy Policy apply to?

This Privacy Policy applies to your use of the "**Website**" www.oceanpresave.com and all products and services that we offer you via our Website.

Personal data

In this Privacy Policy, your "**personal data**" means information or pieces of information that could allow you to be identified as a person.

Your consent

Future Fanbase B.V. will not collect, use or disclose your personal data without your prior consent. Therefore, we ask you to agree to this Privacy Policy before you can use our Website.

Are you thirteen years or younger?

If you are thirteen years or younger, you may not make use of our Website or our services.

Which personal data do we process?

Your personal data may be collected in several ways, for example when you visit our Website, register on our Website, place an order, subscribe to a newsletter, fill out a form, contact us or use our services in any form.

We will ask you to log in through your Spotify account. By doing so, we can retrieve personal data, at any given moment with the access token, and are able to manage your account by using the connection with the Spotify web API.

Revoke access

You can revoke access any time. Once you revoked access, we can't access or control your personal account data from Spotify any longer.

How do we use your personal data?

We use and process the personal data you have provided us with for the purposes described below.

- We use your name, age, location and mail address for marketing purposes;
- We use your email address to send you information and updates about your account. We may also send you information about topics that might be interesting for you. You can unsubscribe from these services at any time.
- We use your public data, subscription details, birth date, personal playlists, your top artists and songs, currently playing track, recently played track, saved tracks and album, see who you follow for analytical purposes;
- We are able to manage your public and personal playlists, access to your saved tracks and albums, control playback on your Spotify clients and Spotify connect devices, read your currently playing track and Spotify connect for specific marketing purposes: like new playlist following, new artist following and pre-save pushes into your preferred playlist.
- We use the data about your browser language, your IP address and geolocation in order to address you in a language you speak and to show you content that relates to the country you reside in.
- In case of fraud, we will share your personal data with the victim in order to allow this person to file a report with the police. We will not share more data than necessary for the report, and we will notify you in advance when we are about to share your data for this purpose.

Who do we share your personal data with?

Future Fanbase B.V. does not sell, trade, or rent personal data to third parties.

Third-party service providers

In order to render our services, there are data that we will need to share with third-party service providers.

Generic aggregated (non-personal) data

We may share generic aggregated data with our business partners, trusted affiliates and advertisers. In such case the data will be fully anonymized.

How do we protect your personal data?

We work hard to protect your personal data from unauthorized or unlawful access, alteration, disclosure, use or destruction. We use appropriate data collection, storage and processing practices.

Cookies

We may use cookies to enhance your experience when you use our Websites. A cookie is a small text file, containing a string of characters that can be placed on your device when you visit a website. This text file uniquely identifies your browser or device. When you visit our Website again, the cookie allows our Website to recognize your browser or device. You can change your cookie settings in your browser, if you don't want cookies to be sent to your device. Please note that some Website features or services of our Website may not function properly without cookies.

We use the following types of cookies on our Websites:

Technical cookies: these are cookies that are essential for the operation of our Website, they enable you to move around our Website and use our features.

Analytical/statistical cookies: we use these cookies to track visitor statistics. We use these statistics to continuously improve the Website and mailings, and thus offer you relevant content. These cookies also allow us to recognize and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors navigate when they're using our Website. This helps us to improve user navigation and ensure users to find what they need more easily.

Tracking cookies: these cookies monitor clicking behaviour and surfing habits. By means of these cookies we can see whether and when you view your profile, and whether you click through to our Website.

Pixels

We may use pixels for remarketing, marketing, and analytical purposes. We use the following pixels on this website: Facebook pixel, Google Adwords pixel and Google Analytics.

Third party websites

You may find advertising or other content on our Website that link to the websites and services of our partners, suppliers, advertisers, sponsors, licensors and other third parties. We do not control the content or links that appear on these websites and are not responsible for the practices employed by websites linked to or from our Website.
